**Past President Charles Lassiter** won \$50 cash in the Carithers Scholarship raffle and immediately donated it to the CART fund.



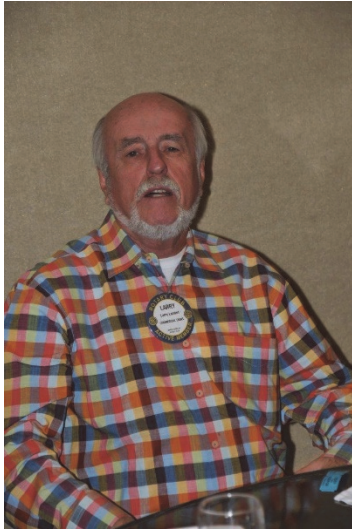
**Amy Erskine** greeted members and guests.

**President Keith Funderburk** called for a vote for the 2020-21 slate of officers. They were elected unanimously by the membership through acclamation.



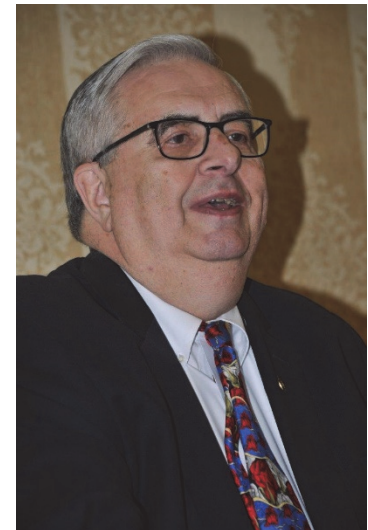
**Past President Sally Platt** introduced the day's speakers.
